



check-out process

- Wash, dry and stow all dishes in proper place
 - You may leave last round of clean dishes to dry on dish rack upon checking out
- Sweep any large chunks of dirt, trash, or food off the floor
- Close windows / turn off any fans, a/c, heat, etc.
- Leave door UNLOCKED hang key on hook



How Things Work



BEDROOM HEATER

This heater is for heating the bedroom only.

For safety, please ensure this heater is off when you are not utilizing the bedroom.

*It is pre-programmed to turn off every morning at 8:30am.

Note: Please do not block these vent with clothes or anything flammable.



AIR CONDITIONER

There is just one black button that you will need to move up/down to trigger on/off. Look at the diagram on the left of the a/c. The black button is on the right.



MAIN HOME HEATER— HEATED MATTRESS PAD (WINTER MONTHS ONLY)

Better than this furnace (which has been removed) is the **heated mattress pad** which will keep you warm and toasty at night!:) Your control is sitting where this arrow is pointing.



WINDOWS

All windows have been prepped for a smooth opening, but this is one of Lucy's 30-year old <u>quirks</u>. **Please do not force the windows to open.**

After unlocking the windows, if they will not open, you may take a butter knife to the outside of the window to <u>CENTLY</u> loosen the seal of the window. From there you can prop open.

How Things Work



STOVE

The stove should always be 'ready for use' upon arrival.

There is a pilot light under the stovetop cover, which causes **the stove cover to be** <u>warm</u> - for <u>SAFETY</u>, please do not rest papers or personal items on the stovetop cover - it remains warm 100% of the time.

WHEN COOKING, If a burner does not ignite fire within <u>4 seconds</u> of turning knob on, please turn knob off immediately.

TO TROUBLESHOOT:

Touch hand gently to the middle of the stove cover - it will be warm. If it is warm, this ensures the pilot light is on. Try to light once more. If stove fails, please contact Brittain.

The pilot light that stays lit unless 1 of 3 occasions cause it to go out.

- 1. someone turned the pilot off
- 2. wind blew the pilot out (when windows are open and breeze cuts through)
- 3. the propane is out (this will not be an issue for guests)

If the pilot light has gone out, please contact Brittain for a very simple walk-through on reigniting.

OVEN

The oven's pilot light is always OFF.

To light for cooking, please follow these simple steps and <u>ALWAYS turn pilot OFF</u> when done cooking.

To light the pilot fire:

- 1. Turn far left knob on oven from off to on
 - a. Wait about 30 seconds
- 2. Grab lighter out of the utensil drawer
- 3. Open oven door
- Under the lowest rack in oven, at the center point, ignite your lighter. If propane is flowing, a small flame will light.
- 5. If flame does not light on first try, try again
- 6. Repeat steps 2-3 times if needed
- 7. If pilot does not light after 3rd try, please contact Brittain.



After the oven pilot is lit, it will look like this.


